As the video monitor is contained within a box (UL listed Nema type 4 enclosure), the video typically runs on a loop. We also provide a remote so you can power the video on or off without opening the box.

The video goes over all the typical steps of Tarping System operation, from initial truck positioning to tarp rollout, pendant control, strap positioning, hook attachment, multi-tarp lapping, tarp raising and centering, tarp lowering and unhooking, strap and pendant return, tarp securing, and departure. Because people learn faster from different media, we have incorporated video visuals, supporting captions and audio instructions to our training station.

Whether you're looking to train new drivers on the basic use of the system or to ensure that veteran drivers are using the system properly, the Video Training Station is an effective tool for increasing the safety and efficiency of your Tarping System operation.
